- 5. A large canvas has an area of 2.4 m². A smaller canvas is exactly half the size. What is the area of the smaller canvas?
- 6.A class shares 156 marker pens equally between 12 children. How many marker pens does each child get?
- 7. A child uses 3/8 of a metre of ribbon. How much ribbon is left from 1 metre?
- 8. A paint bottle holds 2.5 litres. If a child uses 1.75 litres, how much paint is left in the bottle?
- 9. There are 18 boxes of pencils. Each box contains 36 pencils. How many pencils are there altogether?
- 10. A sculpture takes 1 hour and 25 minutes to complete. How long will it take to make 4 sculptures?
